NEOnet Operations Update

- Finance Committee – the first meeting of the Finance Committee will be March 7, 2012 at 7:30 a.m. at NEOnet. Members from the Technology Advisory Committee sitting on the Finance Committee are: Ryan Lekan, Pat McKinney and Kelly Kendrick.
- Board of Directors Meeting – the next Board of Directors meeting will be March 6, 2012.
- DBA Position –NEOnet has hired Brendon Yarian to fill the open DBA position.
- Fiscal Service Position – NEOnet’s Fiscal Services department has an opening for a Fiscal Operations Support Specialist. The job is posted on the NEOnet website at <https://www.neonet.org/web/mycampus/job-opportunities>.
- Building Dedication – a building dedication will be scheduled for the new facility in early summer. Several government officials have been invited to participate.
- Shared Services – Innovation Fund applications were due March 2, 2012. A report will be coming out soon outlining the advantages of city and local governments using ITCs for shared services.

NEOnet Network

- Lightspeed Migration – The new hardware is in place at the DR site. Copley and Hudson are currently running on that hardware. Once everyone has migrated over, the NEOnet box will be upgraded and used simultaneously. The migration schedule will begin after March 9th and trainings will be on an individual basis. More information will be sent out later.
- FormShare Update – The Emergency Medical Form is done and is being tested. Requisition forms are in the process of being developed. Training dates have been sent out. All districts using

FormShare will be contacted regarding billing preferences. Districts can either be billed March 2012 – June 2012 and then July 2012 – June 30, 2013 or March 2012 – March 2013.

- DNS and Server Migrations
 - Eliminating 156.63.41.0 network – NEOnet will be eliminating the 156.63.41.0 legacy network. The DNS will be migrated first.
 - Alpha – all fiscal users will be moved to a new IP address for Reflections and Safari access.
 - Detailed emails will be send out in advance

- Unity Migration – District migration to Unity Connection has begun. A migration scheduled will be emailed soon.
- Call Manager LDAP Integration - the IP phone extension will be input into the Active directory account.
