**NEOnet Update**

- Agreements – Agreements were sent out.
- Facility – The facility committee is still in negotiations for the Richfield facility and is discussing alternative locations.
- Technology sub-committee – Will Koran, Superintendent of the Medina County Career Center, is the chairman of this committee. The committee is researching the costs and vendors to replace our aging server and backup hardware and upgrading the network.
