- Budgeting considerations for FY17
  - Looking to expand Lightspeed as we grow bandwidth

  - Server Refresh- Looking to replace compute at the primary site and add to the existing DR fleet.
- DR Site Expansion- Expanding HVAC; going from 3 to 6 racks
  - Did a comparison for cloud service and hosted data center options
  - DR site expansion has the quickest return on investment
