Denial Of Service Attack

A discussion was held regarding the recent Denial of Service (DOS) attacks.

- Caused an internet outage – were able to remedy the situation within 41 minutes. NEOnet is exploring options and pricing. There may be funds available from ODE to help off-set the costs of the solution. Something will be implemented before the next testing cycle.
- Short-term solution: OARnet put a "policer" on the circuit to limit the UDP traffic.

Lightspeed Update
