Microsoft Agreement

NEOnet Network

- Internet Speeds – NEOnet is looking into options to enhance internet speeds.
 - Exinda – packet shaping appliance put in place to look at bandwidth issues. NEOnet is getting pricing on the appliance. Can prioritize traffic (ie. For PARCC assessments)
 - Bandwidth – NEOnet increased bandwidth another 100 megabit.

- A meeting to discuss the needs for PARCC has been scheduled for April 8th at Noon (lunch will be served).
- Citrix Service – NEOnet is getting ready to launch Citrix for 3 districts. More information about this service will be available at a later date.
