IPcelerate Software Demonstration

A demonstration of this solution that provides multi-cast paging/bell systems and other functionality was presented to the group.

NEOnet Network

- Lightspeed Migration – There are currently 6 live districts on the new filter. The migration is going well. The committee decided on a May 4, 2012 deadline for all districts to migrate over.
 - My Big Campus – user accounts MUST be created for all students and the account list will have to be manually maintained by districts. This can be done using a .csv file.
- Smartnet – Everyone should have received quotes for new maintenance contracts. Anyone interested in adding equipment should contact Chris Zolla immediately. There is a customer portal that will be available to districts with equipment under maintenance that will allow districts to log in and management their items covered in their contract. This will make renewal much easier next year.
- Alpha Server Upgrade – The upgrade to the new server was done successfully. The backup time has improved greatly.
- 156 Network Elimination – The IP address will be changing for Alpha, DNS, and INFOhio. The URL from the NEOnet website will remain unchanged.
 - The committee agreed on August 1, 2012 for this change to take place.

 - An email will be sent out with more details.
- Unity Migration – Everyone is on the new platform.

- iManage Update – will take place on Wednesday, April 10, 2012. After a few days of testing, all districts will be upgraded.
