Items Discussed**Committee Chair and Vice-Chair Nominations**

- Chair – Kurt Gwin was nominated to continue on as Chair and serve on the Board of Directors.
- Vice-Chair – Eric Unangst was nominated to continue as Vice-Chair.
- Both terms are for 2 years.

Denial Of Service Attack

- Review Issue – there was a total of three DOS attacks on the network.
- Remediation Plan – in the short term, NEOnet is working their ISPs to prevent attacks. The long-term solution will require an appliance, which is expensive.
- Grant – The State of Ohio has given a grant of \$2.1 million for ITCs to purchase appliances to prevent further attacks. Five appliances were piloted from 5 vendors. Each appliance was tested.
- Arbor Networks Demo – vendor chosen to provide appliance. NEOnet is using this appliance at the DR site now and will purchase an additional appliance for the NEOnet location. This appliance sits between the router and the service provider.

Lightspeed Reporting

An update was given on the reporting for Lightspeed. The group was asked to “not include the client in images with deployment.” Use group policy or one at a time install. It requires a unique identifier.

- Routing Changes – NEOnet is redesigning routing. Woodridge is piloting.
 - Quicker failover
 - Easier to manage
 - Lightspeed Redesign – has been tested and is working well.
- New Core Switches – upon Board approval, NEOnet will be replacing the 6500 series core switches with 10G and 40G switches.
- Time Warner Upgrades – dedicated 10G between NEOnet and DR site.
 - 10G and 40G.
