## Securly Migration

- a) Fee Increase There is an increase from \$1.00 to \$1.60 per student.
- b) <u>Lightspeed EOL Date</u> The Lightspeed EOL date is July 31, 2018. Districts can begin migrating to Securly now. Securly will provide the majority of the support, however, NEOnet can assist with scheduling and/or coordinating, if necessary. Ben is the project lead for migrating districts to Securly. ## Social Media Archiving

a) <u>Page Freezer Demo – Matt McGing</u> – Matt did a brief demo of Page Freezer and a power point presentation. One of the main reasons that Matt chose to go with Page Freezer is because they offer static pricing unlike other vendors. The presentation will be added to the share folder as reference.

### **NEOnet Network**

- a) <u>Google Classroom</u> Some concern with permission requirements when users are in training. Users aren't able to participate fully during the training session. Districts would have to white list individual domain/drive.
- b) Video
  - <u>WebEx</u> Currently, we have licenses available. The cost is \$60 per account.
  - <u>Video Cart</u> The video cart is mobile and offers a new more flexible way of learning. Districts can offer and participate in distance learning classes with other districts. Currently, working on pricing for the video cart to be set up, delivered and configured.
- c) <u>Two Factor Authentication</u> NEOnet is beginning two factor authentication with staff on a limited basis before rolling out to all employees. We are authenticated everything we can, however, doesn't work with eFP, DASL, or ProgressBook.
- d) <u>District Incident Response</u> A district incident response plan has been shared in the Technology Coordinator team drive in Google. This is available for all districts to use.
- e) <u>Firewall and Security Solutions</u> Ongoing discussion. Currently reviewing all options and will present to the Finance Committee. We have been vetting multiple vendors to find the most cost effective and robust solution for our consortium.
- f) <u>DDoS Cloud Mitigation</u> NEOnet is debating whether or not we need to renew cloud mitigation. Some of the same services are offer by our primary ISP, OARnet. The physical appliances will stay in place for at least another year.

## **Technology Integration Discussion**

The last meeting for the school year is scheduled for May  $8^{th}$  at 9:00 a.m. The meeting would be good for members and nonmembers to attend to learn more about the Tech Integration Service package. More strategic plan and goals for the new year. Google training camps are scheduled for June  $11^{th} - 14^{th}$  and  $26^{th} - 29^{th}$ . Grad credit will be available.
