**Form Share Demonstration**

Richard Horn from Form Share gave a demonstration on their product. NEOnet will obtain group pricing information.

**May Assembly Meeting**

Matt Gdovin went over the presentation given to the MRSC Assembly meeting held May 2, 2011.

Highlights included:

- Changes to the MRSC Board of Directors:
  - Wayne Blankenship, Nardon, and Dennis Honkala, Buckeye, vacated their seats as Chairman and Assembly at Large, respectively.
  - Ed Holland, Cuyahoga Falls, will be Chairman for 2011-2012.
  - Sam Reynolds, Manchester, will be Vice-Chairman for 2011-2012.
  - Russell Chaboudy, Coventry, and Walter Davis, Woodridge, were voted in as Assembly at Large members for 2011-2012.
- NEOnet is in the process of negotiating pricing for a new facility on Graham Road in Cuyahoga Falls. If the move is approved, the plan is to move during the Thanksgiving holiday.
- NEOnet survey results were given in a handout.
- The NEOnet customer satisfaction survey was handed out.

## **NEOnet Network**

- Webwasher Issues – Webwasher is still creating delays in internet speeds. A new version will be installed soon. Please email Chris Zolla ([zolla@neonet.org](mailto:zolla@neonet.org)) if you are having speed issues.
- IP Faxing – this project is delayed until CallManager is updated.
- Arcmail – this project is delayed until all archived mail is imported. Once that is done, district testing will begin.
- Servers – NEOnet purchased new Cisco UCS servers, which will increase memory by 2.5 times.
- Backups – Commvault will be the new backup solution deployed at NEOnet.
- Call Manager, Voicemail and Exchange 2010 Upgrades – all will be upgraded this summer.
