Note: When executing this program, it makes additional changes not specified here. If the employee doesn't have any Y to EMIS jobs, the program will change the DEMSCN to N to EMIS as well. As an example: An employee who is a sub teacher has a jobscn that is N to EMIS, with no separation reason & date, also has a DEMSCN that is Y to EMIS.USPCHG will make the DEMSCN N to EMIS in this situation.

Continue, Re-enter options, or Exit: (C,R,E,?) <C>

This is also true for any employees who have multiple jobs that are now N to EMIS, but the DEMSCN is Y to EMIS. The DEMSCN will be set to N to EMIS when all JOBSCNS are N to EMIS.
