NEOnet Network

- 8e6 Technologies – the M86 boxes are in the testing phase and are working well. Chris Zolla, NEOnet, scheduled additional testing with several districts for September 7, 2010.
- Time Warner Fiber Conversion – There are still 7 circuits which are not testing properly. These will be corrected and all districts will be converted over to Time Warner.
- PB Reports – ProgressBook reports will no longer be given to districts on CD. They are now available online at <https://pbreports.neonet.org>. The username and password are the same as the DASL and ProgressBook username.
- Project Update
 - EmpowerID – NEOnet will be rolling out EmpowerID soon to districts one at a time.
 - DASL/PB Admin Tool – this tool brings the EmpowerID information into DASL and ProgressBook.
 - Website and Portal – this project is behind schedule. NEOnet will be implementing a project plan to get everyone up and running.
 - Voicemail/iManage – The voicemail tool is complete and training will be scheduled. There are still some software issues with iManage.
 - Adobe Connect – NEOnet will be using Adobe Connect for web-based training.
 - SANS – the new SANS and switches are being installed at NEOnet and migration will take place within a week or two.

E-Tech Phone Conference – Steven Crumbacher

- The September 2010 update will be going out this week.
- The 2011 E-Tech Conference registration will be opening within the next few days.
 - Registration rates are the same as 2010.
 - Educational session proposal deadline is October 13, 2010. Complimentary registration for the day of presentation will be available again.
- K-12 Network Funding – This is the same as 2010: \$2,000/building, paid in two \$1,000 installments.
