November Assembly Meeting

The next Assembly meeting will be on November 3rd. They will discuss the following:

- 3 year forecast through FY18
- Approval of estimated appropriations and fees for FY16
- Bylaws and policy changes
- Code of conduct for marketing outside of the consortium

Committee Update

- Finance Committee – will discuss fire suppression systems and feasibility study for the lower level of the NEOnet facility
- Insurance Committee – will meet in January to discuss insurance changes for FY16.
- Fiscal Software Committee – the committee continues to evaluate the Tyler Munis software. The MCOECN pilot for this software will kick off January 1st for 10 districts across Ohio. NEOnet does not have any member districts participating in this pilot.

NEOnet's current organizational chart was handed out. Cheryl Nist has been hired as a new Fiscal Software Support Specialist.

K-12 Network Subsidy

The window for the applications opens on October 9th. NEOnet is unable to make any modifications to the applications this year. Districts must make all corrections and submit to ODE. The Technology Readiness surveys are being loaded into Cherwell and districts will be able to review and update the information within that platform. Data must be validated in order to receive your subsidy money.

Student Registration Online Forms

There are currently two applications that will have the ability to push data from a form back into DASL. The goal is to have this working in early January. NEOnet has had a demo of:

- USASWeb instability – in order to try to remedy the instability, the USASWeb and USASDW applications will be moved to a box with more memory.
- IP Fax outbound issues – most issues have been repaired.
- One Call Now – in November, NEOnet will be allowing districts to self-subscribe to this notification system. Any outages or important information from NEOnet will be relayed through this service.
