### **NEOnet Network**

- Core Switch Replacement- The core switch replacement will be taking place on October 12, 2016 @ 9:00 p.m. During the replacement there will be a possibility of interruptions. The first replacement will be at the DR Site, then at the primary site to help minimize downtime.
- IPv6- The IPv4 address space is depleted. The options available to organizations who need additional address space is to get them through brokering services and purchasing the asset or to move to IPv6. The IPv6 space does not have the limitation of address space that IPv4 faced.
- Cisco Prime Upgrade- The Cisco Prime Upgrade will be taking place in October 2016. This upgrade will render some Access Points useless. If they are 6+ years old, they probably will not work.
