Action Items from Last Meeting

- Lightspeed – 2 Lightspeed trainings have been completed.

- Voicemail Migration – NEOnet has migrated over to the new software. The district migration is on hold until after the move to the new facility.
- Lightspeed Upgrade – The second Lightspeed box is up and running at the DR site. Migration to Lightspeed will be on a per district basis. End users will not notice a difference during migration. Videos transferring from EVL to My Big Campus should not be lost.
- Smartnet Maintenance – Once NEOnet receives the pricing information from Smartnet, information will be sent out.
- Symantec Antivirus – Version 12 will be distributed to those participating. The pricing information will be sent out soon. The software can be purchased at any time and prorated accordingly.
- ASR1001 Router Upgrade – NEOnet has purchased a new router to aid in speed and performance.
- Esler Fax – IP Fax – SR140 is configured and waiting to complete installation by December 9, 2011.
