6. Network Update
- a) Security Vulnerability Scans
 - The Department of Homeland Security is doing weekly scans
 - NEOnet will begin automating internal scans in the upcoming weeks and will send districts reports and information about found exposures. NEOnet will work with districts to find the best solution to resolve security vulnerabilities and secure the network.
 - b) Content Filtering
 - NEOnet is decoupling anything from the Security Bundle that does not include filtering
 - Current pricing
 1. Lightspeed - \$2.10
 2. Securly - \$1.10
 3. Lightspeed Classroom - \$1.25/student

- Please do not wait until June to migrate to Lightspeed. Please schedule demos ASAP
 - c) Middle Mile Upgrade
 - Funds have been made available through the CARES Act to upgrade to a 40 or 100 GB connection
 - d) 10Gbit Internet Services Offering
 - Since moving the network to Everstream, NEOnet has been able to take our 10 GB pricing close to our 1 GB pricing
 - 10 GB is \$43080 before the Erate discount
 - If your district would like to move to 10 GB, please file a new 470 for a new five year contract
