2. P-EBT Data Pull Project
  - a) The federal Families First Coronavirus Response Act of 2020 provides the Secretary of Agriculture authority to approve states’ implementation of a temporary program called Pandemic-Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT). This program will provide EBT cards to every student who qualifies for free/reduced lunch enrolled in schools that qualify to distribute free lunches
    - To ensure all eligible students are included, districts and schools need to certify their students who are eligible for free and reduced-price meals by Wednesday, April 29
    - The Information Technology Centers (and Management Council of the Ohio Education Computer Network) will compile this information and provide the critical data elements for issuance of the benefit card directly to Ohio Department of Job and Family Services on Thursday, April 30
