 - EZQuery>Reports - Students without Disciplinary Incidents was not updated to look at new discipline tables - results includes students with incidents on the new discipline pages
 - R108-C - MISC fees sometimes overlap onto the free-form text when Yes to Include Copied on Correspondence.
 - Same as Student Address checkbox does not display on the Add Student Contact pop-up screen when adding a contact from the Family Group - Contacts tab.
 - Next Generation Assessment, EOC Assessment, KRA, discipline incident pages prints 'guid' data where the actions buttons should appear

 - Please note that the look of DASL will be changing with the 16.0 release. There will be style and font changes along with enhancements on the attendance, scheduling, transportation, I want to... and medical screen.
 - In addition in a 16.x release a Mobile App will be available that will appeal towards school and district administrators on the go. With this app they will have the ability to look up a student, their contact

information, their schedule, attendance, report card grades, and apply a discipline incident. The Access is controlled by DASL security and will most likely require a passcode on your mobile device.

NEOnet will be rolling out another reporting tool offered by the ProgressBook Suite.

 - There will be reports pushed out by State Support that will appear in this list
 - There is also the opportunity to create your own user defined reports. And Save them to be used again. This will eliminate that ER to be able to save your EZ Query-SIS Student Search
 - There is also a feature to schedule a report to run for example daily, and email it to yourself or someone else.
 - Uses views provided (very similar to DASLr)
 - They are currently working on the views so we have not rolled this out yet
 - It will require additional security roles, which will be added to Admins over the summer.
 - NEOnet will provide documentation on how to add your users to the security role
 - NEOnet will begin ad-hoc reporting training after the September DASL Roundtable
