- **Quick Print Schedules and Transcripts**- With a quick check we found only 10 schools have set up their quick print for transcripts, and 8 schools quick print for schedules cards. It really is a timesaver and we feel will help you with 2nd semester starting up to be able to quick print a students schedules.

- **DASL Open Defect Report** <https://neonet.org/content/defect-report>
 - Addresses appearing in ParentAccess when sending the r700 to the vault
 - In the Mobile App in the grades section, duplicate courses are displaying and some grades are not displaying well
 - In the Mobile App, users with only display rights to the View Profile is able to see attendances, grades, etc.
 - Default Staff member assigned to membership group still linked to membership after a staff record is inactivated
 - Unable to view Student Profile if student has a contact with a last name of >50
 - Summative Race and local ethnic are not copying over when processing ITC to ITC transfers (summative race shows after profile saved)
