- HB410/Truancy Update
 - Snow Days with HB410 *snow days were still calculating hours if the building put in future absence dates (vacation, field trip, etc). NEOnet went and erased all hours on snow days by changing the master calendar to a school day, going to daily absence list, deleting all absences, and then changing the master calendar back to snow day. Documentation has now been changed to reflect the new steps.*
 - Multiple pages with letters fix
 - Absence type changes for 18/19-*Buildings can now adjust their absence types to better reflect HB410 changes. Our recommendation is to have fewer absence types and more absence reasons. If you need help with these changes please come to an open lab.*
 - Lunches in 18/19-*As a reminder all students will need a lunch on their schedule. This will make sure that HB410 calculations are the*

most accurate. Please note that there are some scenarios where students may not have a lunch. If you have questions regarding this please don't hesitate to contact studenthelp@neonet.org

 - PERF report workarounds
 - Scenario 1- *if your building only requires a student to not have a full day absence to be considered Perfect Attendance then you will still want to run the PERF Report with the include partial absences UNCHECKED*
 - Scenario 2- *if your building considers a student to have perfect attendance if they have no tardies then the PERF report will work with the include partial absences CHECKED*
 - Scenario 3- *if your building does not allow any absence or partial you will want to run the Yearly absence detail with perfect attendance Ad-Hoc report or Attendance Skipped Students Ad-Hoc report. This will run for the entire district. You will want to export to excel and filter by your building, active statuses, and hours.*

- EMIS Situation dropdown: The EMIS Situation dropdown is sorted by EMIS Situation number which is defined by ODE. To see the situations grouped by Resident, Non-Resident attending, Non-Resident non attending use the Ellipses button



- Score not reported reason M- According to ODE the reason was being used too often so they decided to remove it as an option. The Reason A- Medical Reason or F- Other is still in dropdown to use.

- Slide 4-2018 Graduates End of Course Biology Assessment now shows Red X if not completed in Federal Requirements. Only students that have completed a regularly scheduled or manually entered physical science course prior to July 1, 2015 are exempt from this requirement. BUT, NEOnet was finding students who have taken the course prior to 7/1/15 and it still shows incomplete under Federal Requirements- **Defect submitted!**

- Find out why community schools have to put in a Legal Address of Residence date even when first enrolling a student in order to get it to go over to ODDEX. In addition, is there an Enhancement Request entered to change the name of that field as it is confusing.
