DASL/Student Information - April 2018 Roundtable

- Please run test batches of your transcript before the end of year printing occurs. Let NEOnet know as soon as possible of any issues by emailing studenthelp@neonet.org
- Birth name and Birth gender:** With winter 17.3 release the Transcript (R702) now uses the student's Birth Gender and Legal Name from Private tab **if** a value is available in any of the fields. Otherwise, it uses the Gender and name value(s) from General tab.
- ACT and SAT Subject Categories** – With more and more scores being returned by the testing vendors and imported in DASL please let us know what subject codes you would like printed on your transcript format. Along with how many attempts the district would like printed. (example 2, 3, 4, etc. attempts).

- Readiness Seal- Ohio Means Job-** The OhioMeansJobs-Readiness Seal is a formal designation students can earn on their high school diplomas and transcripts indicating they have the personal strengths, strong work ethic and professional experience that businesses need.

In order to print a transcript from DASL with the Seal placed in the lower corner, users must choose the Readiness_XXXXXX format on the R702 Transcript submission page. Enter the student(s) number ~~or pull over the Membership/Program code~~ of student needing the seal on their transcript.

- Ohio Seal of Biliteracy- CURRENT & IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE** A Seal of Biliteracy recognizes graduating seniors who can demonstrate high levels of proficiency in English and at least one other language.

- State law requires that the following notation of a student's attainment of an Ohio Seal of Biliteracy appear on his or her official academic transcript at the time of graduation: " <Student Name> is awarded the Ohio Seal of Biliteracy for demonstrating high levels of proficiency in English and <foreign language(s)> ."
- Type a message in the Common Text for Transcripts box to display the above message.
- Having the seal print on the transcript is optional. Please contact studenthelp@neonet.org if you want a layout with a seal
